To comply, each entity must (1) provide an electronic format of the report to all Senators (CD, diskette, and/or e-mail); (2) post the report on the website; and (3) submit one hard copy of said report to the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guahan.

| 29-113, Chapter VII, Section 25 | Autonomous Agency Revenues and Expenditures Reported to I Liheslaturan Guahan. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, every autonomous and semi-autonomous agency or public corporation in the government of Guam shall report all revenues and expenditures for all funds under its purview and administration to the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guahan on a monthly basis and post the same on its website. Each monthly report shall be due no later than ten (10) days after the end of each month. | 3rd Quarter FY 2009 April report due 05/10/09 May report due 06/10/09 June report due 07/10/09 |
| 29-113, Chapter II, Part VI, Section 53 | Impact of Tourism Expenditures Report. On January 30, 2008 and July 1, 2008, and on a semiannual basis thereafter, the General Manager of the Guam Visitors Bureau in coordination with the Government of Guam's Chief Economist shall report the impact of tourism expenditures on Guam's economy and employment, including projections of tourism expenditures on Guam, on Guam's economic growth, employment, tax revenues, and other variables, for the next year compared with the previous five (5) years; identify significant tourism expenditures or potential expenditures coming into Guam affecting tourism as well as the impact of the changes in these expenditures. Such information shall be compiled in a report, certified by a majority of the members of the Special Economic Service, and submitted to the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guahan. | July 1, 2009 |
